Dear Partner,

Ten days ago we heard some reports on campus that made us so proud of our women leaders. During the past few weeks, the attention of most students turned to semester-end projects, tests, and finals. A number of women staff and student leaders here in Madison seized the seasonal opportunity to spread Jesus' name on campus.

Hosting Christmas gathering study breaks, they gathered 10 to 30 student women at a time in dorm lounges to share cookies and talk about the significance of giving gifts during Christmas. At each location, a staff or student woman offered a little talk about Jesus being a gift to the world that each one is able to receive.



Around 100 women not involved in our ministry heard the gospel. At least 9 students who heard one of these talks expressed a decision to receive Christ. I think each of these women have a relationship with Christian students involved in our ministry. These connections may really help these young women grow.

Your prayers and support go a long way in making it possible for us to be here on campus. This ministry would not be the same without you.

We pray that you will find rest and enjoy this season in greater ways this year.
